# Drone Insurance Policy Review Checklist

For Recreational and Commercial Drone Operators

Use this checklist to review your drone insurance before renewal, equipment changes, or new flying activities.

## Aircraft & Equipment

- All drones currently in use are listed
- Serial numbers are accurate
- New drones have been added
- Sold/retired drones have been removed
- Accessories have been reviewed

## Contact Details

- Contact details are current
- Business/trading details are accurate
- Policy documents remain accessible
- Renewal reminders are enabled

## Commonly Missed Updates

- Assuming a newly purchased drone is automatically covered
- Starting paid work without updating policy usage
- Forgetting to remove sold equipment
- Not reviewing renewal schedules carefully

## Flying Activities

- My policy matches how I currently fly
- Commercial operations are correctly declared
- International flying has been reviewed
- New work types have been reviewed
- All flying remains within regulatory permissions

## Cover & Policy Documents

- Public Liability limits still suit my work
- Equipment values remain accurate
- My policy schedule reflects current operations
- I can access proof of insurance if requested
- I have reviewed my latest renewal documents carefully
